we will step off at the National Archives. Lunch will be on your own. We will be picked up at the Air and Space museum and head to Red Hot and Blue for dinner. After dinner, those who wish can join us at the nearby Iwo Jima Memorial for the famous Marine Corps "Silent Drill." The rest of the evening is yours to relax perhaps in the cocktail lounge overlooking the historic Georgetown area. Day three will be a tour of George Washington's estate at Mt. Vernon. Lunch on site is included with the cost of the trip. After the better part of the day at Mt. Vernon, we'll visit Arlington National Cemetery. Day four, after checking out of the hotel, will be a walking tour of the west end of the National mall, including the Lincoln Memorial, VietNam, WWII, and Korean War memorials. Lunch will be on your own. After lunch we will reboard our coach and head for home.

Due to the high level of security in some areas of this tour, it is vitally important for your immediate response for this trip. To sign up for these tours, you must provide: Your first name, middle initial, last name, date of birth, social security number, citizenship, country, gender, city, state and zip code. We cannot stress this enough. If you are interested in joining us for this trip, we must have your information "yesterday." The cost of this tour is \$495.00 per person (dbl occ) which includes: transportation, lodging, 3 breakfasts, 3 dinners, and 1 lunch (at Mt. Vernon), including taxes and gratuities.
