Register right away at nationalmuseum.af.mil/visit/tours.asp You will be required to present Government issued ID in order to go on this part of the tour, since the restoration hangars are located on the property of the Air Force Base. All visitors must be 12 or older, with no bags or backpacks. There is only one shuttle bus going to the site at 12:15PM. Don't get shut out of this fascinating exhibit. Upon arrival at the museum you can check-in for this and other specialty trips that are available. When you arrive at Humenik's parking lot on the day of the trip, please park your cars at the CVS end of the parking lot. We will depart from Humenik's at 6AM, and be returning by 11PM.
