FEMA stressed, however, that it is still accepting applications for funeral aid for the families of decedents who died of COVID-19 or coronavirus-related causes. Do you still need to apply for assistance? The FEMA COVID-19 Funeral Assistance Helpline 844-684-6333 is open Monday– Friday 9 AM - 9 PM. Eligible families must call this number to begin the application process. The initial call will take about 20 minutes to start the application process. You will need to provide an original death certificate as well as a paid in full funeral statement of goods and services. If you need either of these documents contact us and we will gladly help get you the required documentation.
